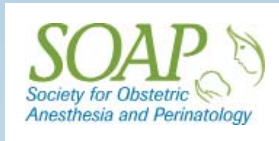

# Program Learning Objectives

## Hands-On Difficult Airway Management Workshop

This workshop is designed to update practitioners on the latest airway data, equipment, and techniques. Following a series of talks and demonstrations that detail various situations in which an airway cannot be established through conventional means, including a discussion of appropriate methods and tools that can be used in the difficult airway management setting, participants will practice these techniques in a hands on training workshop using many types of airway management equipment on mannequins to further sharpen and refresh their skills.

## Urgent Cesarean Section and Failed Epidural Debate

Following this session participants will be able to identify risks associated with regional and general anesthesia following a failed epidural and identify patients most appropriate for each technique that minimize risks and optimize outcome.

## Non-Obstetric Surgery and Postoperative Complications

Following this session participants will be able to discuss multi-disciplinary strategies for fetal monitoring during non-obstetric surgery that optimize outcomes. In addition strategies will be identified that minimize the risk of epidural hematoma and optimize the treatment of post dural puncture headache.

## Changing Demographics in Obstetrics

Upon completion of this session participants will be able to evaluate the impact of co-morbid disease associated with obesity, obstructive sleep apnea and advance maternal age. In addition they will be able to discuss anesthetic management strategies for optimal outcomes.

## Clinical Update and Airway Management

Following this session participants will be able to identify the latest obstetric anesthesia research that impacts clinical practice and also identify strategies to optimize outcome when faced with a failed intubation, including the use of video laryngoscopy in obstetrics.

## Anesthesia Outcomes and Updates

Following this session participants will be able to identify the latest trends and risk factors associated with maternal mortality and will be able to discuss current management strategies for the resuscitation for the mother and the newborn that optimize outcomes.

## Intra-Operative Management

Following this session participants will be able to identify strategies for minimizing blood loss associated with cesarean delivery. In addition participants will be able to discuss the latest recommendations to treat massive maternal hemorrhage and optimize outcomes.

## Pre-delivery Optimization and Anesthetic Management:

Upon completion of this presentation, participants will be able to evaluate and minimize the impact of co-morbid conditions on the pregnant patient, and discuss ways to alter anesthetic management for optimal outcomes.

## Risk Management

Following this session participants will be able to identify how complications impact the anesthesia provider and identify strategies for discussing complications with the patient and family.

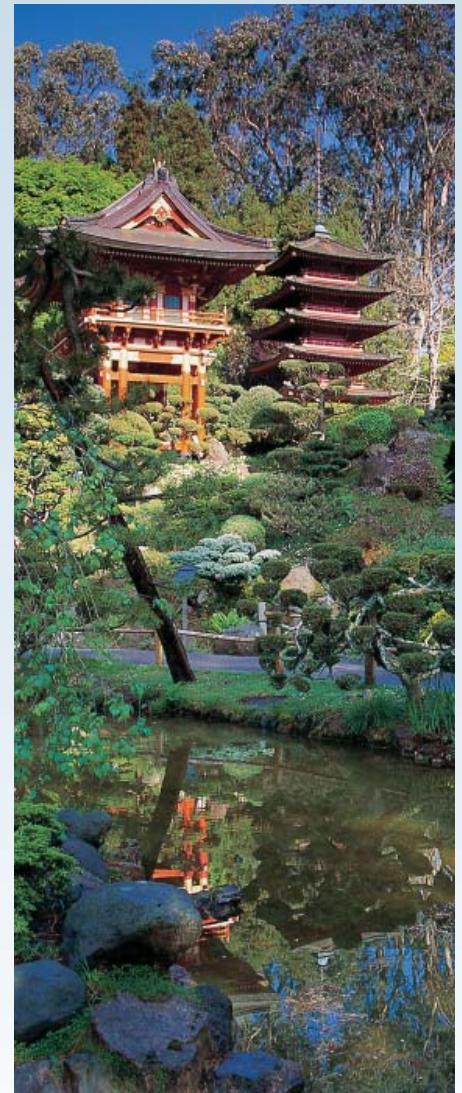
